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HOT WEATHER INFORMATION

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been keeping a close eye on the weather in relation to the end of term events and want to make sure we are as supportive as possible to the children being comfortable and safe at school.

Therefore, we have made the following decisions:

1. On Friday 10th July (tomorrow), children will be able to be collected from 1:30pm. As with the previous heatwave, the school building has managed to stay relatively cool but we envisage the afternoon temperatures in the school being too uncomfortable tomorrow so we are providing parents with the opportunity to collect their children. We have the last merits and FAB5 to hand out in the morning, along with children finishing off some writing tasks.
2. Next week, the temperatures are forecast in the high 20's. Therefore we will continue with correct PE kit for the week or, the school preferred sundresses/tailored shorts and white shirts (which are equally as comfortable).
3. On the afternoon of Thursday 16th we had invited parents into school to look at your children's books and discuss your child's report, if you felt you had any questions relating to the information provided. With the classrooms towards the end of the week very likely to be warm, we have taken the decision to cancel this invitation. Instead, your child's books will be sent home during next week for them to share with you and if you would like to speak to your child's teacher, please contact them via dojo.

4. PICNIC afternoon – last day of term – Monday 20th July.

Due to a Shires Menu technical issue, we are unable to offer the PICNIC lunch options to all children.

1. If your child receives a Free School Meal, there is an offer available on SCOPAY for your child to have a picnic packed lunch. This will be all children from Rec – Y2 and then FSM children from Y3 – 6.
2. All other children will need to have their picnic lunch provided by the parents regardless of your attendance to the picnic afternoon.

The pedestrian gate from Old Town Lane will be open from 12:00.

The children will be brought out to the field by the staff at 12:15.

Children will be directed to parents by school staff (collecting picnic lunch if ordered)

Children whose parents are unable to attend will stay with the school staff and eat lunch.

Parents will be able to leave the school site from 2:00.

There will be a treasure hunt from 1:30 and the ice cream van will also come on site.

All of this is of course dependent on the weather, which, at the moment is forecast for possible showers. We may have to cancel should the forecast change and not support the event.
