Dear Parents and Carers,

We recently wrote to you requesting support with this year's Carnival. The letter also asked for parents to share their child's interest as without a substantial number of children, a float or even a Walking Party would not be possible.

Last year we had 32 children supporting which we felt was just about the minimum to ensure the Float was well represented.

Unfortunately, this year, we have only received 12 letters of interest for children to take part in the carnival and as a result we have made the unwanted decision to inform the Carnival committee that we are unable to support the parade this year. We apologise to those children who were looking forward to being on the float.

As a school, we have proudly participated in the Carnival each year, winning best float or second place on multiple occasions. With this in mind, we are committed to returning to our participation next year and would ask that our parents bear in mind that the Carnival 2027 will be held on the first Saturday in July.

LAST DAY OF TERM

We would also like to use this letter to remind parents and carers that the last day of the academic year is Monday 20th July.

Traditionally we hold our family picnic on the last day and therefore, all parents are invited to have a picnic with their children/families from 1:15 onwards.

The children will have their lunch as normal and then come out to the field (weather permitting) at 1:15 to join their families. Parents and carers can start arriving from 1:00pm to find your spot on the field. We will arrange for the ice cream van to be on site from 2:15pm and families are free to leave from 3:00pm. Children whose parents are unable to attend can join pre-agreed family friends (dojo teachers) or will stay with staff.

To save on wearing uniform for one day, Monday 20th will be a non-uniform day.

On the morning of the 20th there will be a treasure hunt on the field for different cohorts of children. This will involve finding gold discs which the children will be able to exchange for a small gift from a selection of prizes:
