NUT ALLERGIES

Nut Allergy reminder. This is a further reminder to all parents to ensure that we support our children with Nut allergies. We are very keen to explain the importance of not sending foods into school containing nuts due to children attending school with a nut allergy.

Our observations are that the majority of our parents are supporting us being a 'NUT FREE' school but last term we had to remove 3 nut containing items. While 3 items might be judged as a very low number, it only takes 1 item and 1 contact to cause a severe reaction.

FREE BREAKFAST CLUB

On Monday 13th April we started our 'FREE BREAKFAST CLUB' offer from the government.

The breakfast club provides all children from Reception to Y6 with the opportunity to have a breakfast before school.

Guidance is that there is no booking system so parents can access this provision whenever they need to. Entry is through the hall side doors from 8:15 to 8:30. Toast, pancakes, cereals, fruit and yoghurt is available for the children on a daily basis.

We must however share that this facility is a 'breakfast' provision only. It should not be used as a wraparound care provision. Therefore, all children attending will be expected to take a breakfast. Wraparound care provision is still available through our Pelsall Pirates offer.

UNIFORM

At Pelsall Village, we have tried to support our families by simplifying school uniform and PE kit that purchased at a much-reduced cost to labelled or school logo items.

Can we remind all parents that we retain high expectations of uniform and therefore we expect children to be always wearing the correct shoes. Plain black trainer style shoes are allowed but no other colours/styles.

All PE garments should be plain black or white and free of large logos. Please support your child to be part of a consistent uniform that represents the school.
